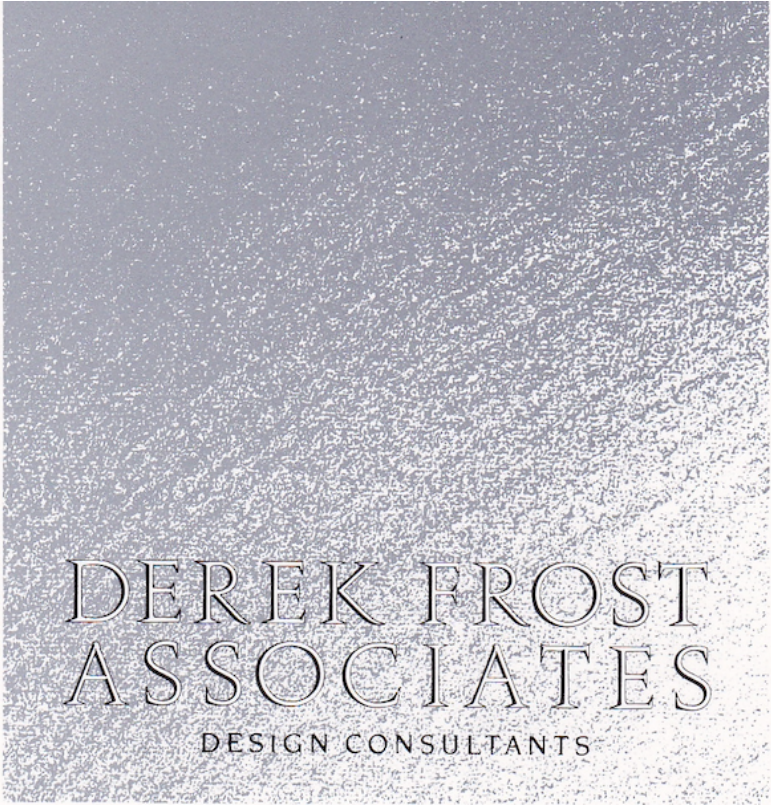
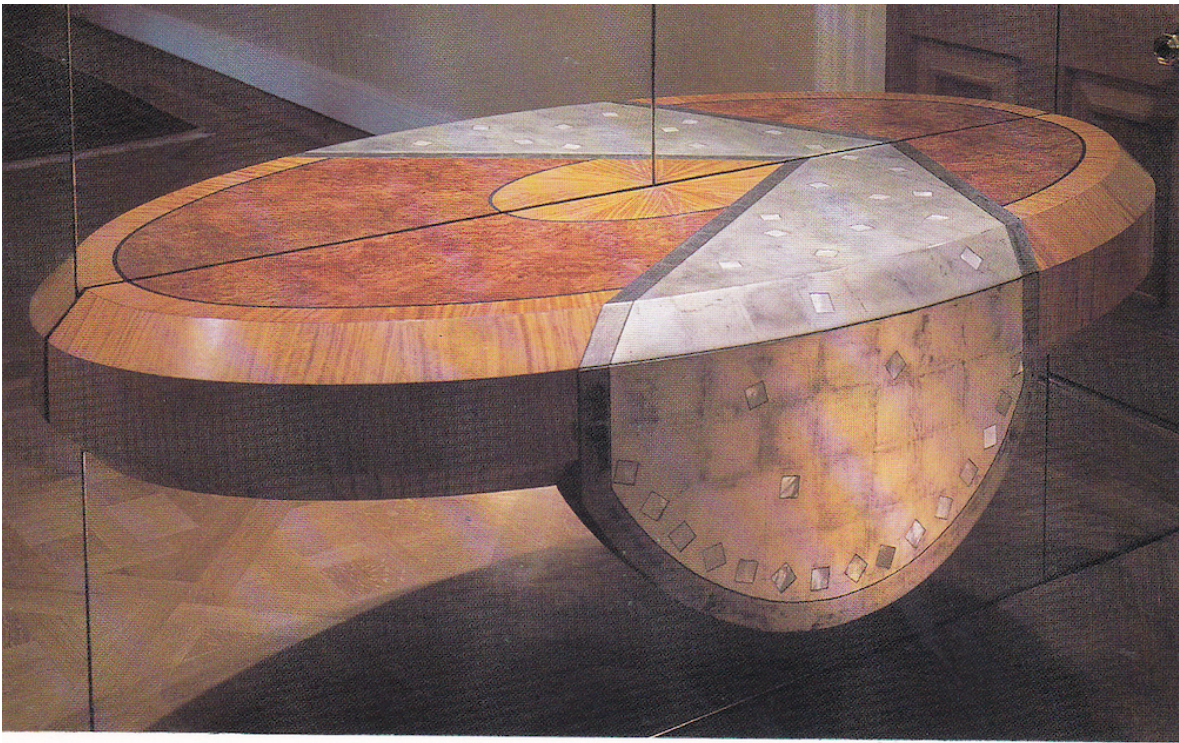

EXHIBITION OF FURNITURE AND DECORATIVE OBJECTS BY DEREK FROST

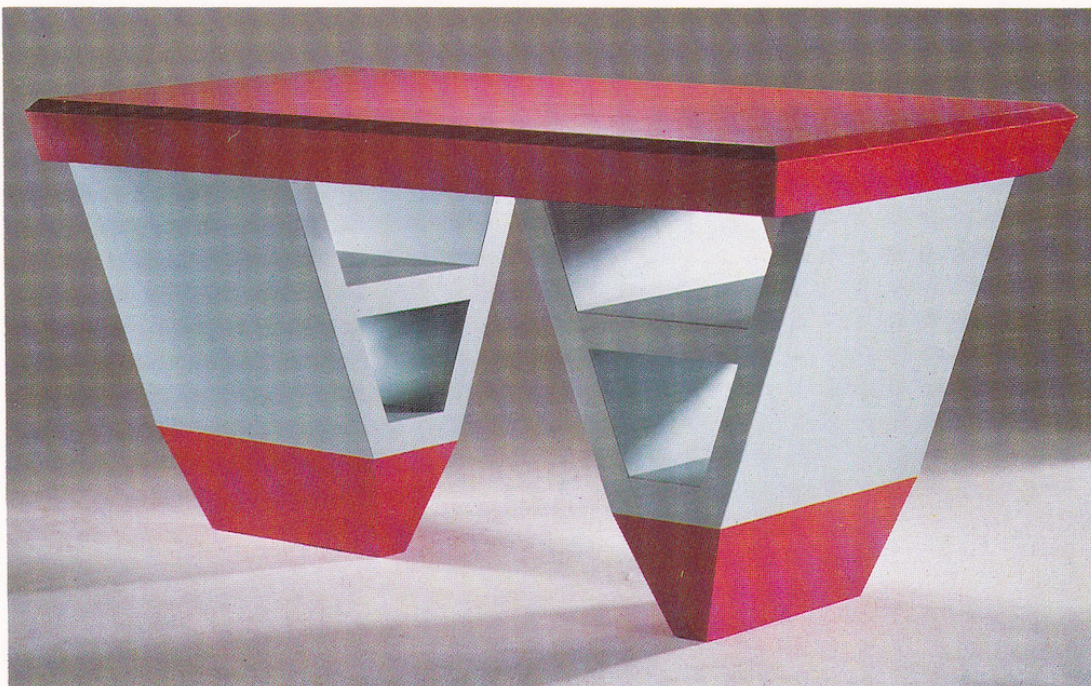
The furniture and decorative objects on display are designed by Derek Frost and are made and finished by some of the finest specialist artists and craftsmen working in this country. They are pieces of high character and quality inspired by a wide range of visual references. Finishes are often exotic combining such materials as mother of pearl, lacquer, metals and fine wood veneers. All pieces are stamped and dated.

A number of pieces are available for sale and the remainder are kindly loaned by private collectors. The exhibition will also include related drawings and photographs plus examples of other product designs and interior installations.

Through this exhibition the designer hopes, not only to make his work better known to a wider circle of potential collectors but also to find opportunities of working with architects and furniture manufacturers on a broader range of furniture commissions.

Constructed in medium density fibreboard with all surfaces clad in Colorcore laminate.

Overall size: 150 cm. wide x 75 cm. deep x 75 cm. high.

Leighton House was the home of Frederic, Lord Leighton, the great 19th Century classical painter and President of the Royal Academy.

Built between 1864 and 1866 to designs by George Aitchison, the richly decorated rooms are the earliest and one of the most important expressions of the Aesthetic Movement in England.

The centrepiece of the house is the Arab Hall added in 1877-79. It was created to house Leighton's collection of Islamic tiles, one of the finest in Europe. It has remained completely intact and is a remarkable monument to eclectic Victorian taste.

The museum is open during exhibition hours, admission free.
